Syllabus for Computer Based Exam (Paper 1):

- I. **General English:** Candidate's understanding of the basics of the English Language, its vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, synonyms, antonyms and its the correct usage, etc. and writing ability would be tested

- II. **General Intelligence and Reasoning:** It will include questions of non-verbal type. The test will include questions on -

IV. **General Awareness:** Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of an educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighboring countries especially pertaining to Sports, History, Culture, Geography, Economic scene, General Polity including Indian Constitution, Scientific Research etc. These questions will be such that they do not require a
